Note. Receipt of your report and the application form for participation must be necessarily confirmed with a notification on receipt. In case such notification doesn't come, please contact the Organizing Committee.

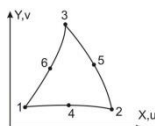
REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PAPERS` DESIGN

- The report must be written on an actual topic within one of the conference directions.
- Volume – not more than 3 full pages; text editor – Microsoft Word; A4 format; portrait orientation; the fields – 25 mm; the font – Times New Roman, 12; line spacing – 1,0.

Requirements for the structural elements of the report

- **Authors** – *Name, Surname* of each author starting with a new line (the font – Times New Roman, 12; align left, without paragraph indention, bold), *scientific degree or position, if there is no degree.*
- **Name of the organisation** – place(s) of author(s)` work (align left, without paragraph indention, the font – Times New Roman, 12). After the name of the organisation, separated by commas, indicate the city and country where the organisation is located.
- **The thesis title** – the font – Times New Roman, 12. Printed in uppercase bold capital letters, centre alignment without paragraph.
- **Main text** – text of the article (alignment - justified, paragraph – 0,63 sm., the font – Times New Roman, 12; line spacing – 1,0).
- **Spacing between elements of the report** – 1.
- **Illustrations (pictures and black and white photos).** Pictures must be grouped. The font – Times New Roman, 12, italics. Pictures are denoted by the word “Pic.” and are numbered successively within the report. If there is only one picture in the report, it is not numbered. Descriptive information, the picture number and its name are placed consistently under the illustration.

- **Tables.** Tables` text size – font size 12. Tables` numerical heading (font size 12) is aligned to the right edge of the table, tables` thematic heading – centered (font size 12, italics).
