

Chernihiv National Polytechnic University begins cooperation with Riga Technical University

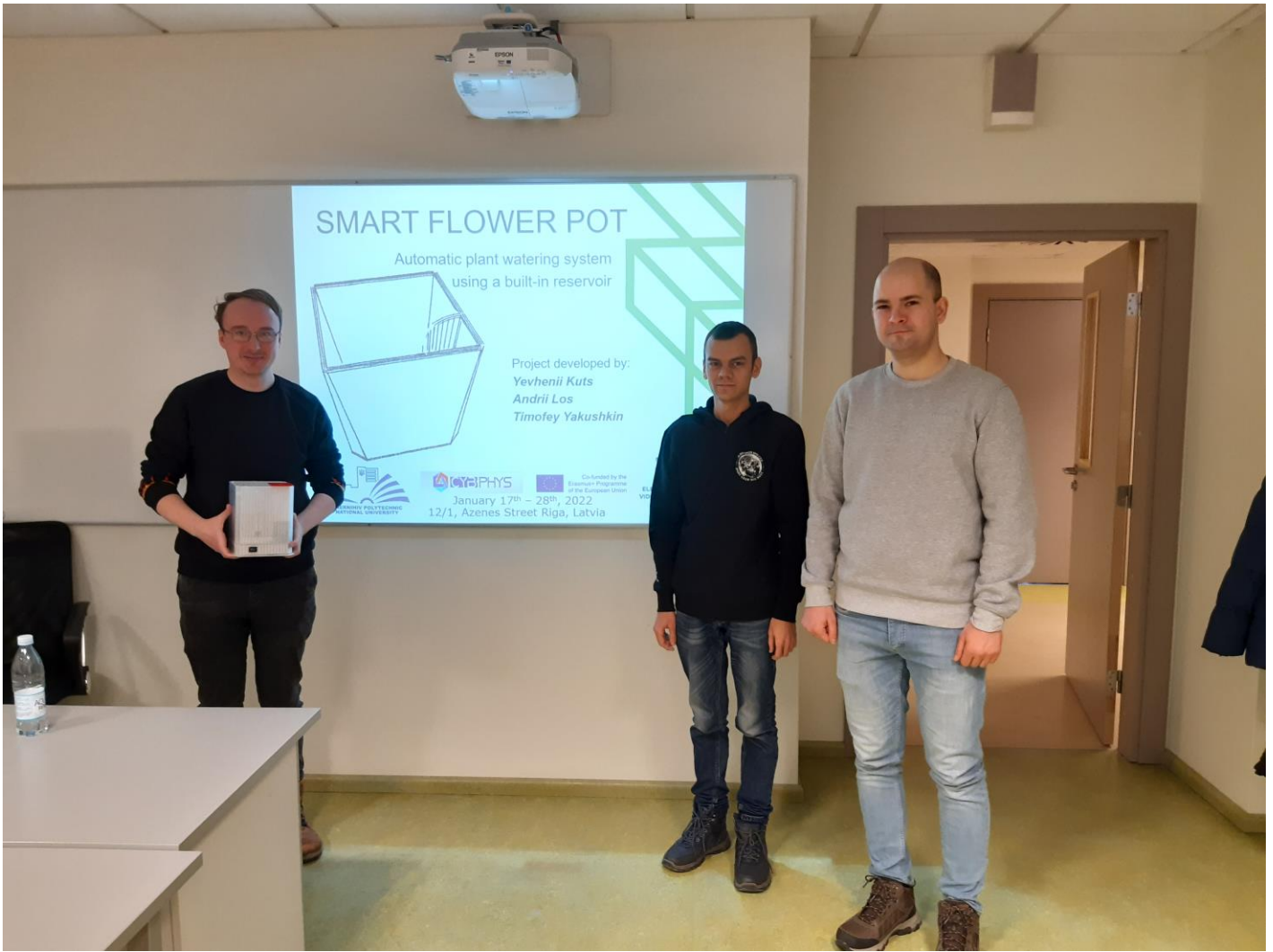

On January 27, the rectors of Riga Technical University (RTU) Leonids Rybitskis and Chernihiv Polytechnic National University (CPNU) Oleh Novomlynts signed a memorandum of cooperation between RTU and CPNU as part of the Erasmus+ project “Development of practically-oriented student-centred education in the field of modelling of Cyber-Physical Systems. Acronym – CybPhys” in the fields of education, science and technology.

After the meeting, the rector of CPNU got acquainted with the technical support of the RTU Design Factory and the metrology laboratory of the Faculty of Computer Science, Transport and Aeronautics. Then he inspected the KUKA exercise robot with a large range of motion, which can be used in interdisciplinary research and virtual training.

From January 17 to 28 students of three Ukrainian universities Chernihiv Polytechnic University, Kharkiv National Automobile and Highway University and Kryvyi Rih National University took part in student’s training school as part of the CybPhys project. They got to know RTU and gained new skills that helped them in the implementation of development projects.
