Requirements to thesis: text, graphics and formulas (MS Equation 3.0); page parameters – paper size A4 with indents up and down 2 cm, left 2.5 cm, right 1.5 cm, Times New Roman font, size 10, line interval – 1,0. In the upper left corner indicate UDC. Title of the report (big "bold" letters) is in the center, on the next line are initials and surnames of authors, further there is a name of the institution (in italics), after a free line the text of the report begins. The thesis should not exceed **three (3)** pages size A4.
