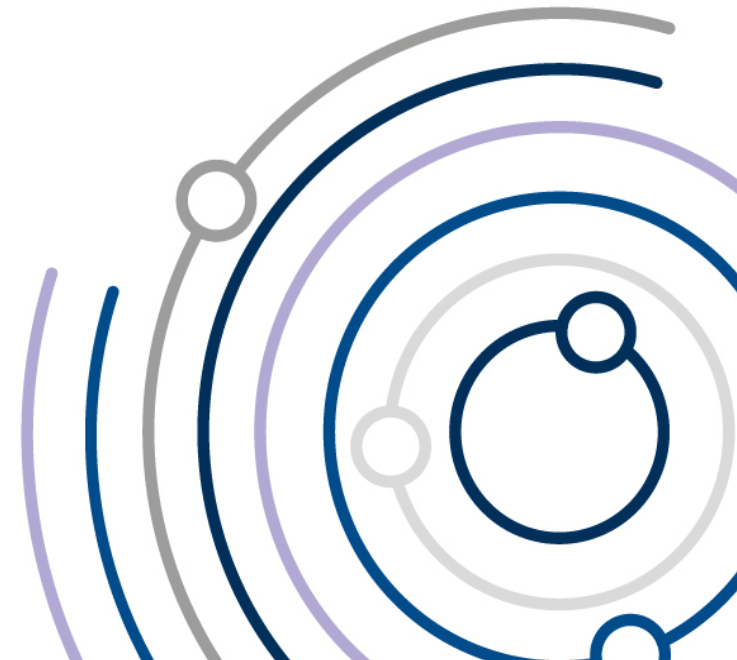

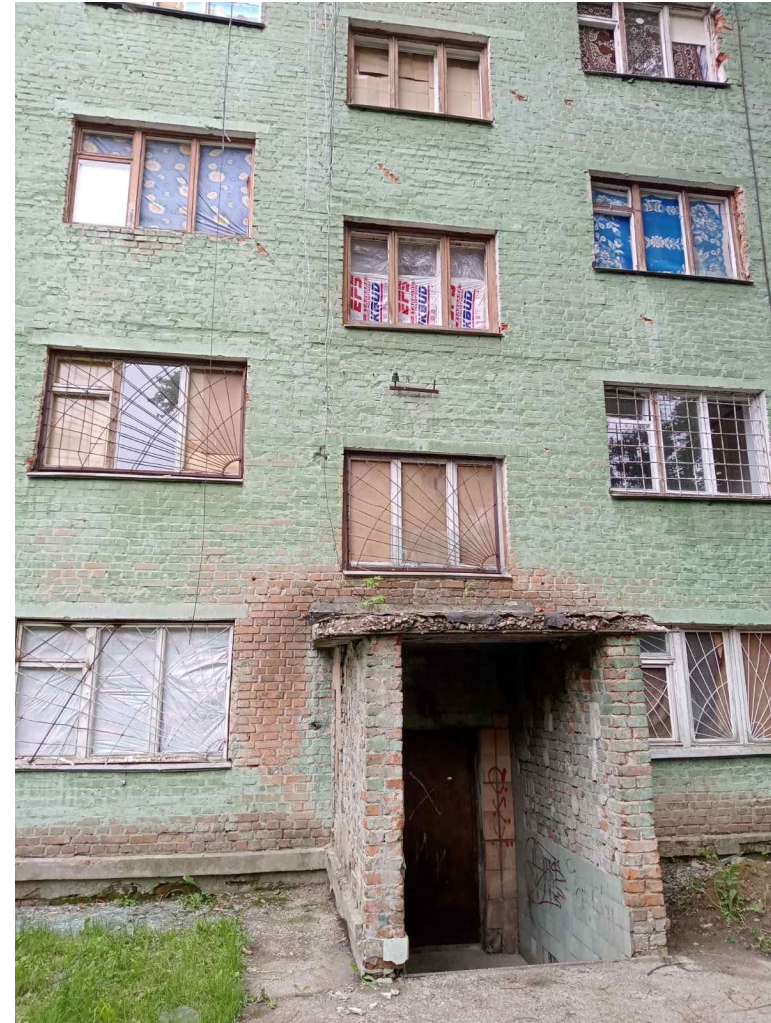

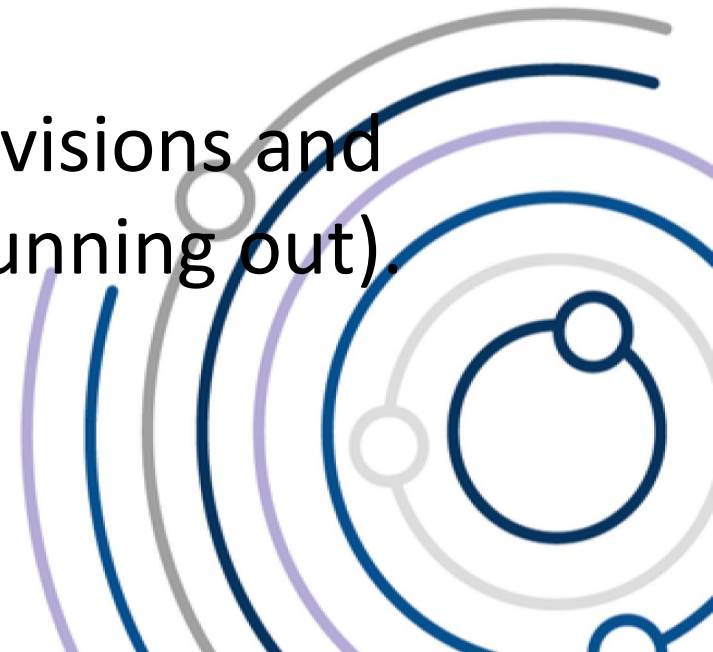

# The university`s destroyed infrastructure



- heating system (1300 radiators)
- windows ( > 4,000 m<sup>2</sup>);
- floor ( > 1,000 m<sup>2</sup>);
- ceiling ( > 1,000 m<sup>2</sup>);
- walls of classrooms, corridors ( > 15,000 m<sup>2</sup>);
- Internal doors ( > 300);
- furniture (most can be repaired);
- material and technical base of subdivisions and departments (inventory process is running out).



# The university's destroyed infrastructure



- The total area of the damaged premises is almost 30,000 m<sup>2</sup>
- The amount of funds needed to restore the infrastructure is more than UAH 140 million

# University recovery plan



## Main stages

- 1. Fixation of destruction** (*prosecutor`s office – building and construction survey expert – survey report – project – defective act – capital or current repair project*)
- 2. Search of sponsors** (*funds, materials*)
- 3. Execution of restoration works**



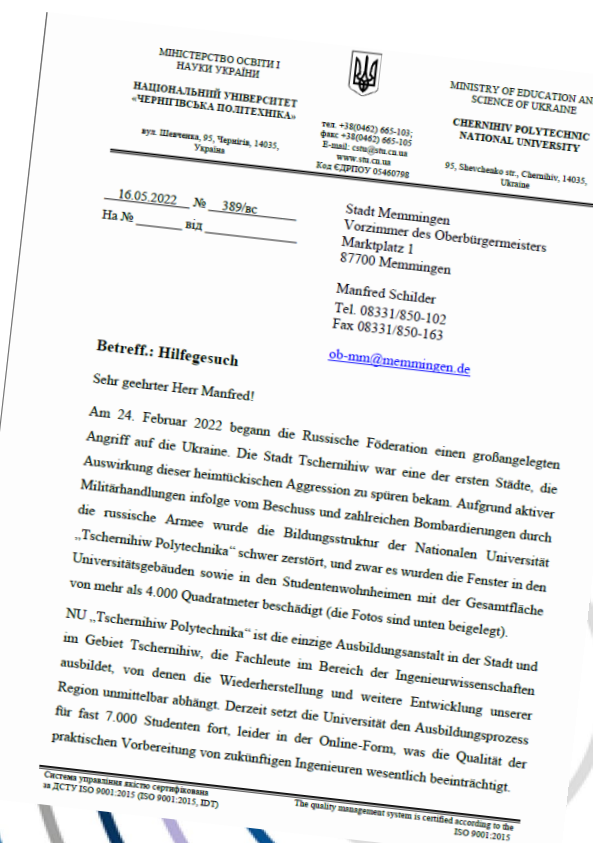
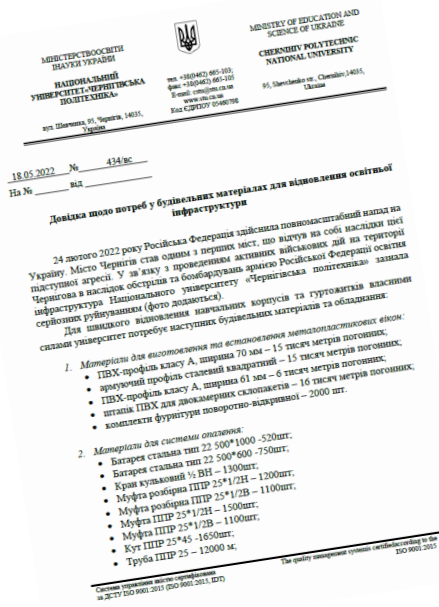


# University recovery plan



Search for sponsors to receive financial assistance and in the form of construction materials.

- Collection of funds for the accounts of the university and NGO “Chernihiv European”;
- More than 50 letters, certificates of needs (to foreign and Ukrainian enterprises, public organizations, famous politicians, patrons);
- Authorized persons (USA, Germany, Poland) FCA Finnish Fund;
- “Energy Efficient University” project (-)
- Involvement of ChNPP employees in the restoration of the university;
- Own efforts (approximately UAH 50 million – windows and heating system)



As of June 30, 2022, the university received assistance in the amount of almost UAH 500,000 (funds, Starlinks, digital equipment, lumber, building materials)

# University recovery plan



- Restoration of the heating system – **till 30.09.2022;**
- Fixing windows – **till 15.10.2022;**
- Repairing of classrooms and offices - **till 31.12.2022;**
- Restoration of the lost material and technical support of units – **till 30.06.2023;**
- Restoration of corridors – **till 01.09.2023;**
- Restoration of sports and health bases Fortuna, Shestovitsa – **till 30.06.2025.**

## Already done

- 90% of garbage has been removed;
- Temporary protective films have been installed on the windows;
- Free hot lunches are organized for all who participate in the restoration of the university

- The survey has been carried out, the project has been prepared and the restoration of the sports hall has started

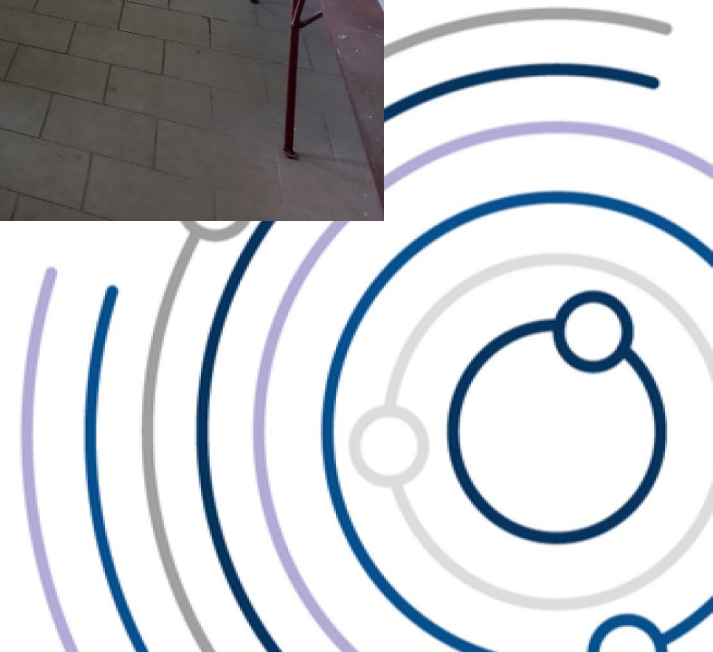

## DRAFT DECISION

I. Fixation of destruction (*prosecutor`s office – building and construction survey expert – survey report – project – defective act – capital or current repair project*) – till 30.05.2022.

II. Search of sponsors (*funds, materials*).

III. Execution of restoration works:

*Restoration of the heating system – till 30.09.2022;*

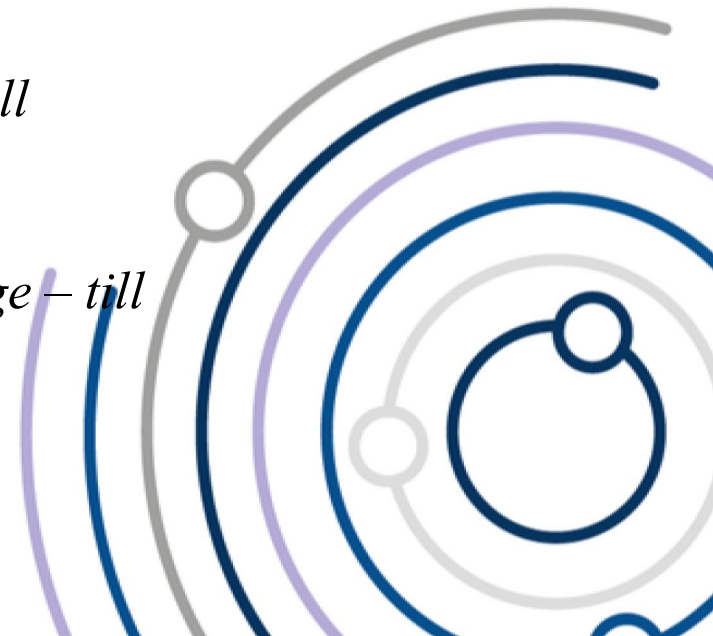
*Fixing windows – till 15.10.2022;*

*Repairing of classrooms and offices - till 31.12.2022;*

*Restoration of the lost material and technical support of units – till 30.06.2023;*

*Restoration of corridors – till 01.09.2023;*

*Restoration of sports and health bases Fortuna, Shestovitsa village – till 30.06.2025.*





## DRAFT DECISION

- To contact the NGO “Chernihiv Polytechnic” and NGO “Association of Graduates of Chernihiv Polytechnic National University” regarding the organization of an information campaign to collect funds for the accounts of NGO for the restoration of the university (responsible – academic secretary)
- To organize the search for international grant programs for the restoration of the university (responsible – department of international relations);
- To continue work on sending letters on providing assistance to foreign foundations, public organizations, patrons (responsible - department of international relations and general department);
- To organize and carry out preparatory work for major or current repairs of all damaged educational buildings and dormitories till June 30, 2022 (inspection – inspection report – defect certificate – project – contracts for the performance of work by third-party organizations) (responsible - V.D. Karabanov, vice-rector, and L.M. Irha, rector assistant for economic issues and SW).
