About the Fellowship

The Ukrainian Summer Methods Fellowship is a waiver of registration fees to attend one three-week session or up to two short workshops in the 2023 ICPSR Summer Program in Quantitative Methods. Find a full course list at https://myumi.ch/W222D.

With support from the University of Michigan's Weiser Center for Europe and Eurasia (WCEE) and the Inter-university Consortium for Political and Social Research (ICPSR), a scholarship fund has been established for the purposes of supporting academic research and quantitative methods training for those currently in Ukraine, or those who have been recently displaced from Ukraine as a result of the Russian invasion and ongoing war.

The ICPSR Summer Program in Quantitative Methods offers training in statistics, quantitative methods, and data analysis for students, faculty, and researchers of all skill levels and backgrounds.
