The publication of theses with the receipt of an electronic compendium and a certificate is **free of charge**.

FORUM CONCEPT

An important role in the process of reintegration of servicemen, veterans and their family members should be played by the key stakeholders of social entrepreneurship: the state, which through incentive mechanisms should determine the institutional foundations and strategy for the development of social entrepreneurship; a community in which social enterprises should be created, social capital and social participation should be formed in order to achieve social changes; business as an investor, partner, mentor; education as a tool for raising awareness of social entrepreneurship, developing entrepreneurship, increasing motivation to establish social enterprises.

The collective of young scientists of the Chernihiv Polytechnic National University is carrying out an interdisciplinary project aimed at forming a participatory model of social entrepreneurship development and determining its role in the process of reintegration of servicemen, veterans and their family members on the topic "Participatory model of social entrepreneurship development: determinants of reintegration of servicemen and ATO/UFO veterans and their family members".

Aim of the Forum: promote the dissemination of national and international experience in the development of social entrepreneurship, create conditions for discussing the mechanisms of





interaction of key stakeholders ("state-society-business-education") in the process of social entrepreneurship development as determinants of the reintegration of military personnel, veterans and their family members.

<u>Requirements for publications in the Collection</u>: The theses should be sent to the e-mail address <u>comferencese@gmail.com</u>, in the WORD text editor (font size 12, Times New Roman, spacing 1.0). Page parameters: bottom, top - 2.0 cm, left - 2.0 cm, right - 2.0 cm, paragraph indent - 1.0 cm. The amount of material sent in this form should be from 2 to 3 full pages.

In the left corner: the name of the direction (font size 12).

Next line: on the left without paragraph indentation - surname and first name of the author (font size 12, bold font).

The next line: indicate – scientific degree, academic title, position (font size 12). Below in italics is the full name of the organization (institution), city, country (font size 12).

The title of theses is across the line in capital letters in bold in the center of the page (font size 12).

Next, in 1 line - the main text with width alignment.

Drawings, schemes, diagrams must be arranged in the form of a single object.

One line after the main text, the list of used sources is given in font size 12 in bold in the center of the page without paragraph indentation, and the list of sources itself is aligned in width, paragraph indentation is 1 cm.

Please do not use automatic numbering.

Tables should not go beyond the text block – font size 12.

All tables and figures must have a title.

References in the text to the source are given in square brackets.
