1. Electronic version of the report. The subject and name of the file must correspond to the surname of the first author of the materials (example of the name of the document: Surname_abstract_c1).
2. Electronic version of the application (Surname_application_c1).

The abstracts will be published in the author's edition. The authors and their supervisors are responsible for the scientific level of the abstracts, the validity of the conclusions, and the reliability of the results.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ABSTRACTS

1. The volume of abstracts is up to 2 pages. A4 format. The text must be typed in MS Word.
2. Margins: all - 2 cm each. Font – Times New Roman, font size - 12. The line spacing is "1". Paragraph indentation – 1.0 cm. Alignment - in width.
3. In the upper left corner it is indicated - the name of the section (subsection); below – Universal Decimal Classification.
4. In the center, the surname and initials of the authors are indicated in bold (for students, the group is indicated, for the supervisor: last name, initials, scientific degree, academic title, below in italics - the full name of the organization (institution), city, country).
5. The title of abstract (capital letters in bold). Further across the line is the main text with width alignment.
6. Drawings, schemes, diagrams must be arranged in the form of a single object.
7. At the end of the text, after one line, there is a List of references (font size – 12). The reference in the text to the source is given in square brackets.
